

### **Missions Notes:**

Turkey— On March 21st, after about three weeks of running around and trying to work our way through a process that we didn't understand in a language that we mostly understand, we closed on a house! Our house is in the right neighborhood (foreigners can't buy in some places), was the right price, is zoned correctly, and gives us papers that we were told would give us the grounds to stay in Turkey for the foreseeable future. The immigration office has confirmed that, between these deeds and documentation from the bank, we have all the necessary documents to obtain our new residency permits. We will be applying for them after Titus gets back from the States the third week of April. Our Father who is in heaven has been giving us what we need, is giving us what we need, and will give as what we need. This was not money that we had in the bank, but a generous supporter of ours agreed to give us a loan. It is our goal to raise \$100,000 from now to the end of 2024 to put towards that loan. If God has put it on your heart to be a part of what we are doing here in Turkey by helping us repay this loan, please let us know.
